

Privacy Policy

“Thank you for visiting the Montana Nurses Association (MNA) website and reviewing our privacy and security statement.”

MNA is strongly committed to maintaining the privacy of your personal information and the security of our computer systems. With respect to the collection, use and disclosure of personal information MNA makes every effort to ensure compliance with applicable federal law, including but not limited to the Privacy Act of 1974, the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1995 and the Freedom of Information Act.

MNA does not collect personal information about you when you visit our site unless you choose to provide such information.

If you visit our site to read or download information, we collect and store the following:

- The name of the domain from which you access the Internet,
- The date and time you access our site,
- The Internet address of the Website from which you linked directly into our site.

The above information is used by software programs on our website to create summary statistics which allow MNA to assess the number of visitors to the different sections of our site, identify what information is of most and least interest, determine technical design specifications, monitor systems performance and assist in making the MNA site more useful to visitors.

If you identify yourself by sending an e-mail containing personal information, this information will be used solely to respond to requests for information or records.
